### **BYLAW 6**

#### **ACT Concessional Registration Scheme**

The ROC has members who are resident in the ACT. Some of these members were covered previously by the RCCACT's membership of the Council of ACT Motor Clubs (CACTMC) for access to the ACT Concessional Registration Scheme. Following the amalgamation of the two Clubs at the end of 2007, the ROC's membership of the CACTMC undertakes this role. To this end, this Bylaw 6 has been prepared:

1. to document the requirements of the ACT Concessional Registration Scheme; and
2. to ensure that all members covered by this Scheme are aware of their obligations.

Road User Services, Motor Vehicle Registry, in the ACT has published *Guidelines for Australian Capital Territory Concessional Registration Scheme for Veteran, Vintage and Historic Motor Vehicles* (the Guidelines) which must be adopted by all members of the ROC who own one or more vehicles so registered in the ACT.

As the Guidelines are published by the ACT Government, the latest version of the Guidelines (provided as a web link on the CACTMC website) forms part of this Bylaw, and shall be the document which applies to the members of the ROC who are resident in the ACT.

The Guidelines state that participants are required to maintain a log of vehicle movements. Any commercially available log book or sheet may be used, provided it allows for the recording of the minimum information stated in the Guidelines.

The ROC is recognised by the CACTMC and Road User Services as a participant of the Scheme (concession number 294).
