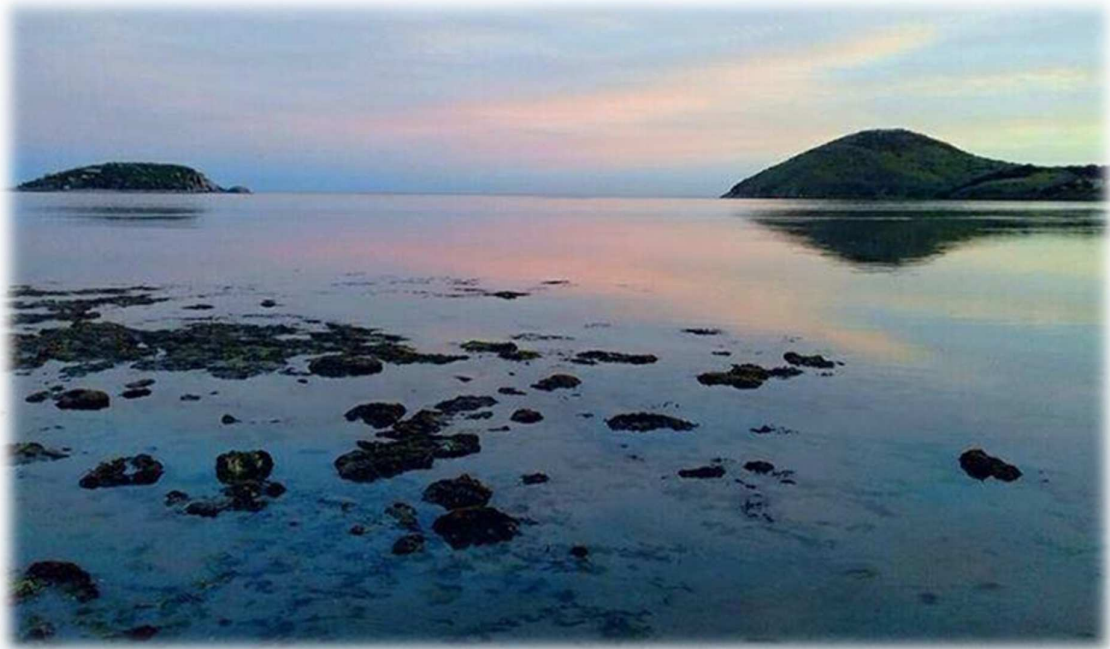
So, for the time being please do not forward your final payment. We will advise any payment amount change and a new final payment date early next year.
